Reading **at least 6 books** over the summer prevents the "summer slide." Our book exchange gives the students a chance to **TRADE** their used reading books for books they have not read! For example, if you bring in five books to the exchange you will receive a coupon to pick out five different books. **Everyone** is encouraged to participate!

Get ready for summer reading!

Here's how...

- ◆ At home, students pick out books they own but no longer want. They then bring them to school on **Wednesday, May 31**.
- ◆ Only bring in books at their age/interest level (or older). **NO YOUNGER BOOKS!**
- ◆ Students will come in with their class to drop off their books.
- ◆ They will receive a coupon for the number of appropriate age-level books they bring. If your child brings in books younger than their grade level, those books will be considered donations and no coupon will be given. (However, this is a great way of cleaning out your book cabinets!)
- ◆ On June 1 and 2, students will come back with their class to select their "new books."
(See schedule on website and reverse side of this sheet.)

Remember: Only age-appropriate books PLEASE. If the student is in 6th grade, bring in 6th grade **interest** level (or older) books. If the book is below the age/interest level of the grade, it will be returned to the student or considered a donation. Please do not bring in dictionaries, Bibles, crossword puzzles, textbooks, damaged, or inappropriate books for the exchange. They will not be accepted for coupons or exchange.
